Our aim is to award someone whose achievements have gone unrecognized but were not unappreciated. Please review the criteria carefully and select members who are worthy of being recognized. The award is based on the activities and achievements of the past administrative year.

In order to nominate a Key Club member for this award, a club president or Kiwanis/Faculty advisor, or school official should submit the application plus an essay of 500 words or less explaining why the individual deserves to be recognized.

Each club may only nominate two members each year. The Lieutenant Governor from your corresponding division will use the following criteria and the essay to pick one winner (per division). Winners from all divisions will be recognized at District Convention.

All applications must be postmarked or emailed to your Lieutenant Governor by March 23rd, 2023

The member(s) you are nominating must meet all of the guidelines on the following checklist

- Must have at least 50 hours of Key Club service completed.
- Cannot serve on the executive board, which includes: President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Publicist.
- Must be nominated by the Club President, Faculty Advisor, or Kiwanis Advisor, or school official.
- Must be a paid member and in good standing on the District and International levels.
- An essay of nomination must be written by the Club President, Faculty Advisor, or Kiwanis Advisor school official.
- Must include a list of projects from the past year in which the member has been involved, signed by the Secretary and Club President?

The member(s) you are nominating must meet 3 of the following 5 guidelines.

- Serve on a committee within your club.
- Chair a project.
- Attend at least one sponsoring Kiwanis meeting.
- Attend 75% of the club meetings.
- Attend District Convention.
